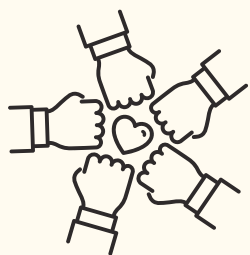

This 3,000 square foot facility will include an 800 square foot commercial kitchen, 48-seat dining room and dining patio, outdoor bar, culinary gardens and for the first time, our very own classroom/office. With a secure long-term lease and a welcoming neighborhood, MAKE Projects will build a strong base of financial sustainability while growing our reach to empower more women while cultivating a more vibrant, multicultural San Diego community. **We are just getting started!**
